# AllSouth Scholarship Program

The AllSouth Scholarship Program is open to high school seniors and current college students (including anyone enrolled in or seeking enrollment in a four-year university, college, trade, or technical school) who want to further their education. Please review the following information and requirements before applying.

## **Eligibility Requirements**

Applicants must meet all the following requirements:

- Scholarship applicant (not applicant's parent/guardian) must be an AllSouth member in good standing for at least 60 days.
- Applicant's transcript must reflect a GPA of 3.0 or higher (weighted).
- Applications must be completed in full. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Application deadline is Thursday, April 10, 2025. Applications received after April 10, 2025, will not be considered.

#### Instructions

- 1. Complete the application in its entirety. You may attach additional sheets if necessary.
- 2. Make sure to include all required attachments, listed below, with the application. Attachments will not be returned.

Scholarship applications and related attachments will not be returned. Please do not submit original copies.

## Required Attachments

Please submit the following attachments in addition to the completed application to AllSouth. Only applications submitted that have all the required attachments will be eligible.

- Copy of high school or college transcript with GPA.
- A letter of recommendation attesting to the applicant's character from a teacher, school official, community leader, or supervisor. The letter should be dated and include the referrer's name, address, and phone number. It must also state how long and in what capacity the referrer has known the applicant.
- Essay (500 word minimum) that describes how furthering your education will impact your life and community.

#### Criteria for Selection

In addition to eligibility guidelines, the following will be considered in selecting recipients:

- 1. Academic Performance Academic performance and awards/recognition.
- 2. Letter of Recommendation Letter attesting to the applicant's character from a teacher, school official, community leader, or supervisor.
- 3. Activities Community and school activity, involvement, leadership positions, and employment.
- 4. Essay Short essay describing how furthering your education will impact your life and community.

#### Distribution of Award

AllSouth will award a total of \$15,000 in scholarships. The funds will be awarded to four different student members: two (2) scholarships in the amount of \$5,000, and two (2) scholarships in the amount of \$2,500. Scholarship winners will be notified the week of May 19, 2025.

#### Limitations

AllSouth officials, employees, and immediate family members of AllSouth employees are not eligible for this scholarship. Immediate family members include spouse, children and grandchildren, parents and grandparents, siblings and all the "step" relationships of the same (for example, stepfather, stepsister, etc.). <u>Prior AllSouth Scholarship recipients are not eligible to win again.</u>
